a) participants lists, registration, further promotion

b) participant information

At latest on Tue. 05.09.2017 we send out information to the participants of your workshop. This includes information on the venue, the schedule, and the workshop pass. If you want to include some extra information, please send me over a respective text.

c) Registration desks / Collecting your conference bag&badges

The infodesks at the Meervaart Theater, will be open for registration/collecting your badges and conference bag, etc. at the following times:

Tram 1, direction de Aker: Meer en Vaart stop. Keep Slotterplas to your right, you will then see De Meervaart on your left after a four-minute walk.

Tram 17, direction Osdorp: Ruimzicht stop. This stop is right on the Meervaart.



P You can park your car at the Parking garage, located very near to the theatre at Osdorpplein 249, 1068 ER Amsterdam. Coming from de Lelylaan (A10 junction 106) take a right turn at the T-intersection. Turn left at the second traffic light. You should see the Parking garage at your left-hand side. From there it is just a two minute walk to the theatre.
