Only a few days left! We are very much looking forward to having you in Amsterdam for the conference! Here are some more **details** to guarantee a successful and interesting visit.

A) Registration desks / Collecting your conference bag & badges

Please take your ticket(s) with you.

The infodesks at the Meervaart Theater, will be open for registration/collecting your badges and conference bag, etc. at the following times

Please note, in order to avoid jams/delays, make sure that, if possible you make use of the **pre-registration service on September 11th** already. Especially, in case you arrive only on the main days of the conference, make sure at least to be there enough in advance, to avoid long queues/jams. Registration desks open grouped by first letters of your last name.

You get a conference bag at the registration desk. You find all informations (such as WIFI and Programme) you need for a successful conference in there

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Tram 1, direction de Aker: Meer en Vaart stop. Keep Slotterplas to your right, you will then see De Meervaart on your left after a four-minute walk.

- Tram 17, direction Osdorp: Ruimzicht stop. This stop is right on the Meervaart.

CAR

You can park your car at the Parking garage, located very near to the theatre at Osdorppelein 249, 1068 ER Amsterdam. Coming from de Lelylaan (A10 junction 106) take a right turn at the T-intersection. Turn left at the second traffic light. You should see the Parking garage at your left-hand side. From there it is just a two minute walk to the theater.
